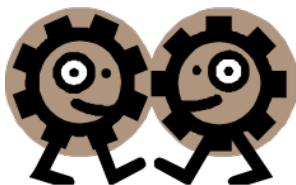

- Identified stakeholders for partnership

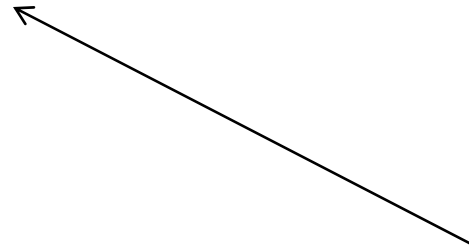


Key Stakeholders Met

- Others were identified as process continued

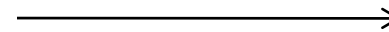


No additional funds to support initiative with changes at lead agency
