Results included PREVENT report, environmental scan, and mapping of services and abuse rates



Kansas learned about other states' prevention plans as part of PREVENT Institute in order to inform the KSFP

Kansas develops Strengthening Families Plan (KSFP) based on PF



Partners agree to conduct research on parent involvement using a complexity framework

Connections with SFNN, national, KECCS, state, and local partners



Kansas receives ECI grant and partners with R&R



Training for ECE providers



Communities hear about SF (in Wichita and Garden City) and starts gathering partners



ECBG funding supports programs addressing KSFP priorities to expand the reach and effectiveness of state work to implement SF



Groups begin plans to be SF communities including everything from constructing housing to family supports
